International Working Class Solidarity in the face of capitalist globalisation

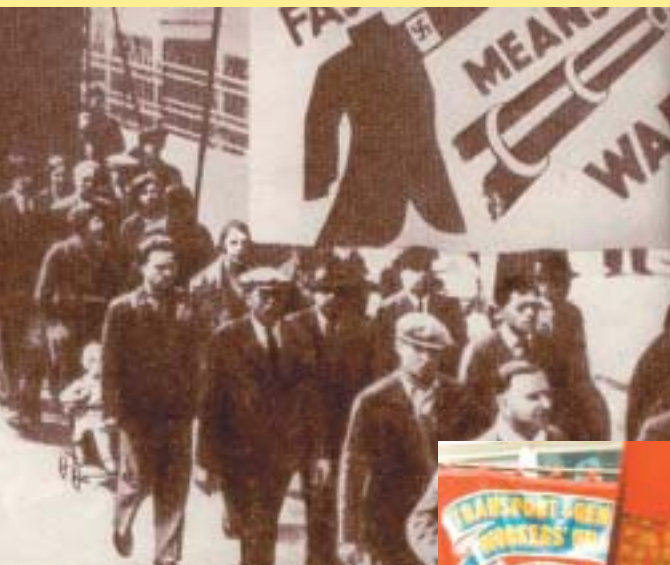
May Day gives us an opportunity to push home the message of London's opposition to privatising the tube and other public services.
